Footnotes

FORCE DE LA NATURE stalked the pace four wide, drew even leaving the turn, kicked clear and widened. HOLIDAY SOIREE contended between horses, was caught in tight and steadied near the seven-sixteenths pole, angled in and came again and fought on well to earn the place. LOBSHOT was forwardly placed four wide, dropped back a bit leaving the turn, came back again through the stretch and was making up ground. LUNE broke a step slow, rushed to contention along the inside, forged command with a quarter to run, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. JUST LIKE JULIET was shuffled back early and unhurried into stride, circled five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. SPADRA was away alertly to set the pressured pace, was collared between horses after a half and gave way readily once headed.
