LADY REPENT set the pace from the start, stayed out in the three path on the turn and lasted late under pressure. REVELSTOKE reserved for a half, made a run along the inside late on the turn, angled out for the drive and was gaining late. DANCING DARCEY forced the early pace outside, raced in the four path on the turn, dropped back into the stretch then made a late gain. LEDA outrun early, raced off the inside on the turn and made a solid late gain. EDDIKINS within striking distance, raced in the four path on the turn and rallied belatedly. KATY LIED was no threat. DIXIE JULEP prompted the early pace between rivals, held on well to the final quarter and tired. CLIFFY'S DYNAGIRL failed to menace.
