LITTLE MISS MUFFET set the pace inside, repulsed a bid by the runner up on the turn, fended off a bid by that same rival in midstretch then held sway late. DOROTHY'S AURORA closest to the pace off the inside, challenged the winner on the turn, made another run at that one in midstretch then was gaining slightly late. MAGIC MOONDUST forwardly placed from the start, challenged three wide on the turn but weakened late. TARPY'S WISH within striking distance three wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. VOLCAT broke slowly, raced in the three path on the turn and was no threat. SOUTHERN DRIFTER drifted in at the start and failed to menace. FALCONESS hopped in the air at the start, rushed outside, moved to challenge four wide late on the turn but tired in the drive. SWAKOPMUND was no factor. GRACE WAS GIVEN close up off the inside, faded. BARGAIN BLITZ reared at the start, was outrun.
