**Footnotes**

AMARETTA gained the lead inside early, opened a clear advantage on the backstretch, expanded the margin in the upper stretch, then was kept to her task to hold SISTER CRIMSON safe. The latter, well placed while in behind the leaders from early on, angled five wide into the stretch, drifted in at the sixteenth pole when soundly roused with the whip on the right side, then continued to lug in the remainder. GREAT RED HOPE, outrun early and saving ground until the stretch, came out from between foes four wide for the drive but failed to gain in the late stages. THEALCHICAL drifted in at the start, tracked the leaders four or five wide, continued prominently into the final furlong and flattened out. FORYOUMYLOVE, outrun for six furlongs while saving ground, came out three or four wide for the stretch run, improved position but couldn't threaten. DAINTREE, sluggish to start and bumped by CONTESSA HALO, was hustled along to force the pace three abreast, held on well for six furlongs and tired. MORNING RIDE settled in behind the leaders four wide but faded on the second turn. CONTESSA HALO leaned in at the start bumping DAINTREE and wasn't a factor. CURVE AHEAD went up to contest the pace early from between foes, held on well for six furlongs and faded.
