Footnotes

LUBANGO set the pressured pace between horses, edged clear entering the stretch, then was all out to just last. BAKHOOR was allowed to settle along the inside, wheeled out five wide entering the stretch, finished full of run and was gaining with every stride. SUMMER UPCOUNTRY pressed the pace three wide, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. INDIAN TREATMENT was forwardly placed off of the inside, shifted out and bid between horses entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. BAZINE stalked the pace four wide, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the bid. AMAZING SPIRIT bobbled and was bumped hard at the start, was rank to place and pulled to contention between horses, but came up empty entering the stretch and faded. DEETS pressed the pace along the inside for a half and retreated. STORM MAKE'N showed little. KNIGHT COMMANDER was outrun. ESPRESSO JOE showed brief foot between horses but was through early and dropped out.
