STAKES Louisville H. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 each by 12:00 noon, Friday, May 20, 2011. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Saturday, May 21. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, May 14, 2011 with 27 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Half mile.).

KEERTANA contended between horses, angled in on the final turn, slipped through along the hedge to join the leader with a quarter to run, battled through a prolonged drive, brushing with GUYS REWARD late and was all out to prevail by the narrowest margin. BEARPATH settled in hand between horses, ranged into striking distance through the final turn, angled out entering the stretch to continue the rally, was bumped hard near the furlong marker when EL CRESPO came out and again with a sixteenth to run, kept on through a determined drive but just missed. GUYS REWARD shifted out early, took over before going a quarter, set the pace off of the inside, dug in gamely to meet the bid of KEERTANA a quarter out, brushed with that one in the final yards, fought hard but grudgingly gave in. EL CRESPO chased the pace three wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch, drifted out under left handed urging and bumped BEARPATH hard with a furlong to run, came out and bumped that one again near the sixteenth pole and flattened. MUSKETTIER (GER) was allowed to settle, moved up five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. MEMORIAL MANIAC failed to respond. FREE FIGHTER was away alertly, angled in to dispute the early pace, settled off of the lead on the first turn, but came up empty after a mile and dropped out.
