### Footnotes

JUST A BILL forwardly placed three wide, reeled in the leader after six furlongs, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and proved narrowly best. MAJOR SCORE outsprinted early, advanced three wide into the stretch and closed well on the outside. BLUE SOLITUDE well placed early, angled out a bit for the drive, was blocked in upper stretch, found a clear path nearing the furlong marker and was gaining late to miss. MIAMI ROCKSTAR closest to the pace off the inside, challenged on the second turn then held on gamely the remainder to miss. FORT DEFIANCE reserved three wide, made a solid middle move in that path but could not sustain the rally. SUNDAY GROOM was no threat. BIG BERNIE flipped prior to being loaded in the gate, set the pace, held on well to the final furlong and faltered. STEALING COPPER broke in the air and was outrun.
