Footnotes

MEADOW TRAIL set the pace near the rail, repulsed a bid by WHYPRINCESSWHY with a quarter mile to run when that one challenged in earnest, drew clear in midstretch and held sway late. MISS ELIZA forwardly placed three wide, rallied willingly on the outside. LAVENHAM drifted in at the start, raced close up while off the inside and lacked the needed closing bid. KAELINS GRANDGIRLS outrun early, moved to the rail late on the turn and finished well late. WHYPRINCESSWHY closest to the pace off the inside, challenged the winner late on the turn but tired in the drive. EVERYBODY LIES within reach early, had little left late. CLASSIC EMILY unhurried along the inside, came off the rail nearing the stretch and could not threaten. ALPHA TAMMY lost his left iron momentarily at the start, raced four wide late on the turn and could not menace. ROBIN MY GIRL was no threat while four wide. DEPUTY SAMMIE bobbled at the start and was outrun.
