



SET THE SAIL was closest to the pace three wide, inherited command nearing the furlong marker, opened clear and was all out to just last. GRANDSTAND was allowed to settle, came four wide, finished well and was getting to the winner with every stride. BIMAH was allowed to settle, split horses to make a late rally and was along for the show. THUNDEROUS G settled saving ground, got through to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. MUCHO MACHO UNO was unhurried into stride, came six wide and finished with a belated gain. SOUTHERN JOY stumbled at the start, settled saving ground and passed only the tiring ones. LEROY JR. hesitated at the start, settled five wide and was never a factor. BOCELLI sprinted well clear to set the pace, but faltered entering the stretch and faded fast once headed. LITTLE OFFICER contended between horses for five furlongs and dropped out.
