### Footnotes

DYNAMICAL closest to the pace while in hand and three wide, challenged when ready on the second turn, drew off into the stretch and was not menaced while kept to the task. MR. PRODUCER within striking distance early inside, moved off the rail on the second turn, angled out for the drive and finished willingly to be second best. DOWNTOWN GHOST reserved three wide, angled to the inside with three furlongs to go and could not threaten. JUST FOR TODAY forwardly placed four wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. WICKERSHEIM sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside, stayed on to the final quarter and stopped. NEVER CROSS was outrun.
