Footnotes

TRAIN HEIST disputed the pace between horses, shook clear entering the stretch and widened. HUMOR'S PUNCH set the pressured pace three wide, was unable to match strides with the winner but kept on well to hold the place. LAOPE pressed the pace along the inside, weakened entering the stretch but had enough left to hold the show. COUNT THE GOLD settled between horses, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. NUMEN LUMEN saved ground to little avail. KOWBOY KODY broke slow, pulled five wide but was never a factor. CHAMP KAMAL chased four wide for a half and dropped out.
