Footnotes

CATNIRO gained the lead at the start, controlled the pace while racing near the inside, settled into the lane with a clear advantage and was kept to his task to hold sway. RESURGENCE, within easy striking distance and four wide, was put to a drive when angled wider three furlongs out, reached closest attendance to the winner for the final furlong but wasn't good enough. TACO TUESDAY, outrun early and four wide, moved six wide entering the lane and was going well at the end. HIZZONER settled in behind horses early, eased out seven wide at the quarter-mile ground, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but lacked the needed response. MOHIGAN HILL, well placed inside from the beginning, was asked for his best approaching the stretch but was empty in the drive. ICAN'THEARYOU, unhurried inside early, saved ground into the lane, angled five wide in the final furlong but couldn't threaten. CHARMED FLIGHT went up early to press the winner three or four wide, raced close up to the stretch and faltered. EL BRETTE stalked the leaders four or five wide for six furlongs and tired.
