**Footnotes**

PASS THE DICE close up along the inside, responded in the stretch and was up in the final stride. SANTO GATO vied for the lead three wide, drew clear in midstretch but was outfinished. RED MASERATI forwardly placed from the start, steadied in traffic entering the turn, recovered to be prominent into the stretch but lacked a late bid. NEXT PAGE outrun early, made a bold five wide run on the turn but could not sustain the bid. HIGH STAKES close up three wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. TURBO CAT within striking distance, made a five wide run to the quarter mile marker but lacked a late bid. MAJESTIC LITE within reach early, steadied midway through the turn when four wide then was no late threat. STREETFIRE never far back while off the inside, tired. STRATEGIC WEALTH vied for the early lead between rivals and tired. DOC LA POINTE was no factor along the inside. THAT OLE CHESTNUT was no threat four wide. CRYPTO PETE was outrun.
