Footnotes

MOON OVER GOSHEN stalked the pace three deep, launched his bid four wide, battled hard through a prolonged drive and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. WINTER CANYON was allowed to settle, ranged up five wide through the turn, loomed large entering the stretch, poked his head front with a furlong to run, fought through a long drive, had his jockey lose the outside line inside the sixteenth pole, recovered quickly but was unable to shake the determined winner. TIZ A THEME settled in hand, came four wide and finished willingly to earn the show. BIG BUFF rushed to the lead along the inside, was collared leaving the turn and gave way readily once headed. BUSTEM LOOSE was unhurried into stride, circled five wide and finished with a belated gain. INFALLIBLE was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and retreated. LOOK AH YONDAH out broke his jockey, was awkward into stride and was always outrun. HUMOR'S PUNCH was close up three wide, but was collared between rivals after a half and stopped.
