**Footnotes**

RED'S HONOR gained the lead early, edged in to make the pace from the three path, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage and was kept to his task. MECKEME, well placed from early on while near the inside between foes, eased out and bumped for a stride with HOLY BURRITO approaching the five-sixteenths pole, advanced five wide into the stretch and slowly was reducing the winner's margin. DANCE MUSIC (ARG) settled two or three wide early, lacked room approaching the stretch, again was blocked at the furlong grounds behind MECKEME, split foes soon after four wide and offered a mild gain. HOLY BURRITO, never far back while following the leaders four or five wide, bobbed after being bumped for a stride approaching the five-sixteenths pole by MECKEME when one was angled out, continued five or six wide and lacked a late response. SCREENPLAY settled three or four wide early, was checked behind foes approaching the stretch when lacking room, swung out six wide for the drive and failed to muster a closing threat. ROCKING TRICK (ARG) angled in early to press the winner three or four wide, raced forwardly into the lane and weakened. STORM'N J R, outrun on the backstretch and seven or eight wide, edged in a bit on the turn, came out again to race 10 wide in the stretch and never menaced. WAVE faded inside approaching the stretch. IDE BE SPENCERS, five wide in contention for a half, weakened nearing the stretch and was seven wide. The stewards posted the inquiry sign involving MECKEME and HOLY BURRITO on the turn. Following a review of the video tape replays, stewards found insufficient evidence for action.
