Footnotes

T. C. CHAMP contested the pace along the hedge, forged a narrow lead after a half, shook off TACTICAL WEAPON entering the lane, edged clear and held safely through the drive. ROCKET LEGS pulled between horses for a contending position, was blocked and waited through the second turn, got through lane and was making up ground once clear. SELF MADE MAN stalked the pace in hand, loomed large entering the lane but went evenly through the final furlong. STRATOSTAR was unhurried into stride, came five wide to make a mild bid and improved position through the lane. TACTICAL WEAPON vied for the lead two wide, disputed the issue to the final furlong and tired. SENSATIONAL HUMOR was taken in hand at once, advanced from between horses to make a mild bid but failed to seriously threaten. LOCONIA saved ground to no avail.
