INCA KING disputed the pace four wide, kicked clear entering the stretch and maintained a safe advantage. STRIKE IMPACT contested the pace along the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner but kept on gamely to hold the place. NO INFLATION tracked the pace three deep, failed to menace the winner but continued on willingly and narrowly missed the second spot. SAM P. contended along the inside, but went evenly through the drive. VEILED PROPHET was unhurried into stride, came five wide to make a mild rally but lacked the needed late response. GUADALCANAL saved ground to little avail. ON MY DIME failed to respond.
