Footnotes

STREAK OF THUNDER set the pace inside, responded willingly when challenged before a half, battled KING EXPRESS to the final furlong and edged off late. SPEEDY SOLUTION reserved near the rail, angled out for the drive, bumped SOME KINDA TROUBLE in midstretch then was gaining late. KING EXPRESS pressed the pace off the inside and held on gamely. TSUNAMI KING within reach of the leaders while reserved, raced in the four path on the second turn and lodged only a mild late bid. SOME KINDA TROUBLE close up three wide, was bumped in midstretch and weakened. RIDETHEHIGHCOUNTRY outrun early, saved ground on the second turn and could not threaten. PEACEPIPE HIGH within striking distance, raced four wide on the second turn and tired.
