Footnotes

SCAT CHIEF set the pace along the inside, edged clear entering the stretch and gamely led throughout. HURRICANE ELVIS settled saving ground, worked his way to the outside between horses through the second turn, came five wide and finished well but was unable to reach the winner. DOUBLE CROSSING (IRE) pulled to contention off of the inside, was hemmed in to inside the furlong marker, found room late and kept on well. WANDERING KITTEN was unhurried into stride, shifted out and was making up ground between horses. MARCHING ORDERS tracked three wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but faltered in the final furlong. PISGAH STATION pressed the pace three wide, but came up empty entering the stretch and retreated. WHITEWOOD INDIAN was allowed to settle four wide and failed to respond. ALL BORN SINNERS trailed.
