Footnotes

GOODTIMEHADBYALL was allowed to settle off of the inside, circled six wide to make his bid, quickened in the final furlong and was just up. PHILIPPE settled in hand, moved up four wide to join the leaders, kept on well but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. SHRILL broke slow, advanced between horses for a contenting position before going a half, split rivals entering the stretch, continued on well and was gaining steadily. CLOSERWALK was away in good order to set the pace two wide, weakened between horses in the drive and gave way. IN THE BEAT was away slowly, angled in to save ground, closed the gap on the turn, got through entering the stretch, altered course to the outside for the final sixteenth and was making up ground. ANDERSONSTATE was forwardly placed three wide to the final furlong and faltered between horses. MAXIMUS RULER pressed the pace along the inside to the stretch and dropped out. UNBRIDLED VENTURE contended four wide for a half and retreated. BLUEGRASS BULL was through early.
