Footnotes

WITH ANTICIPATION gained the lead early, raced three or four wide, edged clear while controlling a pedestrian pace for six furlongs, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage and increased it late under intermittent urging. PROFIT OPTION settled inside early, saved ground until the stretch, angled four wide when straightened for the drive, couldn't menace WITH ANTICIPATION but outgamed GRITTY SANDIE for second. GRITTY SANDIE broke through the gate prior to the start and was briefly loose. He was reloaded and settled inside under a rating hold, came out to make a run four wide from between foes into the stretch and couldn't threaten the winner while improving position. AIR ROCKET followed the leaders four or five wide most of the way and failed to rally. WILLIAMS NEWS forwardly placed inside from early on, angled outside the winner on the final turn but flattened out in the drive. THREE WONDERS stalked the pace four or five wide until the final turn and faded.
