Footnotes

TEMIS (CHI), taken in hand early, angled inward, raced four wide, came out and circled rivals eight wide into the stretch, then closed determinedly to be along in time. K. C.'S GIFT, unhurried early while near the inside, moved four or five wide into the stretch, stuck a head in front briefly between calls in deep stretch but was outfinished. DEVILLIOUS, ridden a bit early to gain a stalking position four wide, advanced steadily to take over in the upper stretch, then weakened late. DYNAMESCH, outrun early, made a run five wide entering the upper stretch and offered a mild gain. WORD PUZZLE, well placed inside from early on, eased out three wide for the drive but flattened out late. ORNATE was sent to the fore early,made the pace until the stretch and weakened. JOVE'S AUBEE failed to menace. EL RAFFY (IRE) went up early to press the pace from between rivals, raced forwardly for nearly six furlongs and tired. ONDATOP, forwardly placed inside from early on, faded on the second turn.
