Footnotes

BRASSIE PRINCE forced the pace three abreast from early on, reached the front just before going a half, moved clear and was kept to his task. RAYWICK, outsprinted early, rallied four or five wide into the stretch and offered a mild gain. WINCHESTER BAY, well placed in behind the dueling leaders early, made a run four wide into the lane, loomed a solid threat between foes for the last eighth but was empty when the real test came. GET IN GEAR drifted out while breaking slowly, stumbled in his third stride, was outrun for a half, moved up five wide for the last eighth to reach a striking position but failed to continue. LIMA TANGO was unprepared at the start, was outrun four wide for a half, came out eight wide for the drive but failed to fire. OUR BOLD ENSIGN came in at the break exchanging bumps with PRAYFORSNOW, attended the pace between foes, raced forwardly to the lane and weakened. PRAYFORSNOW came out exchanging bumps with OUR BOLD ENSIGN at the start, moved to the front soon after, angled to the rail, made the pace for nearly a half and tired.
