QUIET MAN close up early three wide, dropped back a bit and angled in once on the backstretch, advanced inside on the second turn, slipped through a small opening along the rail near the sixteenth marker and finished well to be up in time. SETON HALL prompted the pace off the rail, challenged when moved out to be four wide on the second turn, gained a short lead in midstretch but was outfinished. CASINO DAN within striking distance four wide, lodged a mild bid on the outside. MR. TICKET set the pace inside, moved off the rail on the second turn, angled out a bit for the drive, drifted in near the sixteenth marker then weakened. ON LOCKDOWN close up inside, angled out, challenged three wide on the second turn but tired in the drive. TETRADRACHM reserved early, moved out to the three path with three furlongs to go but was no real threat. AVENUE B outrun for a half, raced four wide on the second turn and was no factor.
