Footnotes

HERITAGE OF GOLD, away well, went up early to stalk SILVERBULLETDAY from the outside, was floated out on the first turn and raced five wide in hand, continued under wraps while six wide on the backstretch, was carried out further on the track entering the stretch when challenging, was tapped once with the whip on the left side, increased her lead and was gathered up late. SILVERBULLETDAY moved to the fore soon after the start, was eased well off the inside on the first turn and into the backstretch, raced five wide while establishing moderate fractions, was brought out six wide entering the stretch and wasn't a match for the winner in the drive. ROZA ROBATA, a bit edgy in the gate prior to the start, broke sluggishly, settled inside, made a strong move inside the leaders approaching the end of the backstretch, continued within easy striking distance into the stretch, was angled four wide for the drive but was empty. RUBY SURPRISE, within striking distance while in between foes and saving a bit of ground, moved outside ROZA ROBATA five wide for the drive but failed to respond. SILENT ESKIMO, outside SILVERBULLETDAY and HERITAGE OF GOLD from early on and six or seven wide much of the way, was finished by the second turn.
