Footnotes

DOUBLY FUN, lightly rated early while tracking the leaders four or five wide, advanced from that position approaching the stretch, reached the front a furlong out, then was under brisk urging the remainder. SUMMERHILL GAL, bumped at the start, settled quickly in behind rivals, raced in hand three or four wide, angled out a bit and split foes five wide in the final furlong and finished well. DEVILLIOUS edged in early to press front-running HOLY HOPE (BRZ), gained a slight advantage just before going six furlongs, then grudgingly weakened late. TECHNICAL KEY, nicely placed along the inside from early on, reached the front from the rail between calls at the quarter-mile ground but failed to sustain the needed momentum. SILKS FOR DI broke sluggishly and awkwardly, was unhurried for a half, made a sweeping run five or six wide on the second turn, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but came up empty. CIMPLY SAVIO, in contention throughout, failed to rally. DIXIE LIL', outrun early and five or six wide on the backstretch, came out eight or nine wide for the drive but failed to respond. HOLY HOPE (BRZ) gained the lead early, maneuvered inside, made the pace for almost six furlongs and tired. MISS THE MARK was outrun. ISLAND ROYALTY stumbled at the start, ducked out bumping SUMMERHILL GAL, then wasn't a factor.
