Footnotes

MCKEE'S GALLERY came out at the start bumping SOLID SILVER STAR, was never far back while lightly rated four wide, moved four wide to reach the front a furlong out, then was all out the remainder. BULL MARKET gained the lead early, edged near the inside while clear, lost the advantage to the winner at the eighth pole and held on stubbornly the remainder. TRITON MISSILE, well placed near the inside from early on, eased out three of four wide in the final furlong and bested the others while unable to menace the top two. DANISH DANCER (ARG) raced inside early, was checked when lacking room in the upper stretch, lost position, eased out three or four wide in the last eighth but couldn't seriously menace. GOT THE GOODS raced between foes three or four wide into the final furlong and flattened out while dead heating with BOLD TRUTH for fifth. BOLD TRUTH pressed the pace to the stretch while four wide and tired while finishing evenly with GOT THE GOODS. SOLID SILVER STAR, bumped at the start by the winner when that one came out, raced five wide and tired.
