BERBERIS attended pace three wide in hand, launched a bold bid leaving the turn, shook clear and widened through the drive. PULPIT'S SECRET was away alertly, angled in to set the pressured pace, was no match for the winner but stayed on well to hold the place. DONEGAL COUNTY was unhurried into stride, circled five wide and was along for the show. QUIET ASSAULT prompted the pace three wide, but faltered between horses in the final furlong and faded. STRIDING AHEAD was bottled up toward the inside, steadied near the seven-sixteenths pole, was hemmed in through the turn, angled out entering the stretch but lacked a response once clear. BEAMER showed little in a dull effort.
