Footnotes

AWESOME ARCENO vied for the lead from the start, gained a short lead in the four path midway through the turn, drew clear into the stretch and lasted while drifting out late. DAVID THE GREAT within striking distance, moved in to be near the rail late on the turn, angled out a bit for the drive and was gaining while carried out late. MO'MILLIONS out sprinted early, raced in the three path on the turn, angled out a bit for the drive and made a mild late gain. TENNIS RACKET vied for the lead from the start, stayed out in the three path on the turn and gave way in the drive. NATIONAL BEAR outrun early, was no threat. NUMEN LUMEN forced the pace outside, raced in the five path on the turn and gave way. DAYS RIDE quickly moved to a forward position after breaking slowly, held on well to the stretch and faded. DELVIN'S A HATER attempted to drift in early, was outrun to the stretch and was never a threat.
