MISS FORTUNATE, within easy striking distance, moved inside on the far turn, rallied from the rail into the stretch, gained a slim lead when straightened for the drive and edged clear late under strong handling. TAPPY, never far back, raced four or five wide, advanced outside the winner into the upper stretch, gained even terms for the lead but couldn't sustain the needed momentum as second best. FOOTLIGHTS, reserved inside early, saved ground throughout, made a solid run along the rail into the final furlong but came up empty the last eighth. HERDY'S CHARM tracked the pace three or four wide from early on, moved with the winner while inside that one entering the stretch and flattened out. A. P. AMAZON, angled inside early, was unhurried to the far turn, made a run five wide upon going six furlongs was empty when straightened for the drive. MARY SCOTT, bumped from both sides at the start and checked, failed to rally. AUNT CONNIE moved to the fore inside early, raced in hand while drawing well clear, showed the way to the stretch and gave way. DEEP IN MY HEART drifted in at the start bumping MARY SCOTT, never menaced and wasn't persevered with in the stretch when hopelessly beaten. TIME GOES FAST came out at the start bumping MARY SCOTT, raced forwardly for a half, faded and wasn't persevered with the last eighth.
