Footnotes

MUSICAL BEAUTY, in hand along the inside early, had to await room a quarter-mile out, moved out between horses four wide, took over in the upper stretch and was hard ridden the remainder. SERAPH, outsprinted early, moved inside on the turn, came out six wide for the drive and was going well at the end. SAVANNAH WAY, well placed inside early, eased out between horses four or five wide for the drive, was just off the winner for the final furlong but couldn't offer the needed response. SASSY SIX, outrun three wide to the stretch, worked her way out eight wide leaving the furlong grounds and offered a mild gain. FLAIL, in a striking position between foes four or five wide into the stretch, was empty late. WILD FLOWER, six wide early, remained in contention five wide into the final furlong and flattened out. DASHING GIRL attended the pace between foes three or four wide for a half and weakened. JUDGE SOPHIE, six wide early, edged in a bit on the turn, forced the pace, gained a narrow lead between calls nearing the stretch but faltered in the drive. BACKWATER NIKKI moved inside on the turn and never menaced. RED RAGE attended the pace early while between foes four wide, took over, held on

well until approaching the final quarter and tired. RAISING SALEM, seven or eight wide early, never was prominent. SLAUGHTER AND RUN faded after a half.
