Footnotes

LENATAREESE, never far back, worked her way inside leaving the backstretch, rallied near the rail entering the lane, took over, then was hard ridden to hold TWILIGHT GALLOP safe. TWILIGHT GALLOP drifted in at the start bumping CHARMING HUMOR, was unhurried early, raced in behind horses to the stretch, came out six wide for the drive and was going well at the end. STORM'S DARLING tracked front-running VICTOIRE BATAILLE from early on while three or four wide, moved with the winner while outside that one entering the lane but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. ABBEYS RUNNER, outrun for a half, raced four wide into the final furlong and improved position while not a serious threat. CHARMING HUMOR, bumped at the start, was well placed five wide into the upper stretch, then flattened out in the drive. VICTOIRE BATAILLE sprinted clear three wide, made the pace until the stretch, came further off the inside and tired. LOVE POWER, outrun to the stretch, never menaced while passing tired foes. GOLD MARGARITA, checked soon after the start, was done after a half. ROYAL BANKER, bumped at the start, faded early on the turn while five or six wide.
