**Footnotes**

SOYUZ, outrun early, advanced three wide on the second turn, came out five wide into the stretch, made a bold move to the lead in midstretch and slowly increased his advantage under steady urging. SEA BERT RUN, within striking distance three wide, angled out four wide leaving the second turn when making a mild gain, reached closest to the pace in upper stretch but lacked a late bid and held the place. MINISTER GENERAL, far back early, angled out four wide with a quarter mile to go and closed willingly late. PLEASANT ITALIAN, within striking distance inside, moved off the rail on the second turn, steadied in midstretch when in tight, recovered, was angled out and rallied willingly late. GUIDED TOUR forced the pace between rivals, stayed well to the stretch and tired. SILVER ON SILVER prompted the pace three wide, drifted in with a furlong to go placing inner rivals in tight then tired. PAJARO CANTOR, outrun early, was no threat. MUY CALIENTE, forwardly placed off the inside, tired. PAST STORY steadied from between the leaders entering the first turn, recovered to race within striking distance, was three wide on the second turn and faded. HALL PASS vied for the lead inside, took over on the backstretch, held well to the stretch, steadied with a furlong to go when in tight then faded. K T FIVE HUNDRED, unhurried early, was no factor. LORD RUTLEDGE angled in after a quarter, raced along the inside on the backstretch and stopped. A foul claim by the rider of HALL PASS against the rider of PLEASANT ITALIAN for interference in the stretch was not allowed.
