WINI JONES went up to press front-running SENTIMENTAL ANGEL soon after the start, raced in hand, took over just prior to going a half, edged clear, was tapped once with the whip on the right side, drew off and was in hand late. CHEROKEE SQUAW broke sharply, settled within easy striking distance, moved with the winner while outside that one approaching the stretch but couldn't match strides in the drive as second best. FIREY COMET, outrun for a half, circled foes six wide into the lane and couldn't menace the top two while improving position. WILD RIO had no rally. SHOW ME THE WIRE weakened after a half. SUMMER CLASSIC wasn't a factor. SENTIMENTAL ANGEL made the pace inside for nearly a half and gave way.
