RELIC REWARD, angled in on the first turn when a forward factor, challenged from the inside on the second turn, took over in upper stretch when ready and drew clear under steady handling. HANARSAAN awkward at the start, was unhurried early, commenced his rally three wide on the second turn and finished willingly to be up for the place. TIBADO, close up off the inside, lacked the needed late bid. LEESTOWN, forwardly placed off the inside, raced three wide on the second turn and had nothing left late. MARRON GLACE (ARG) set the pace off the inside but tired in the final furlong. POWERFUL GOER, within striking distance off the inside, tired in the drive. REFORMER RALLY, outrun early while saving ground, was no factor.
