PROF. MCGONAGALL gained the lead near the inside early, was clear most of the way while controlling the pace and was kept to her task in the drive. RHYTHM IN SHOES, never far back, edged in three wide, was between horses three or four wide for the drive and couldn't reach the winner as second best. OCEAN SILK, unhurried early, moved five wide on the far turn, was put to a drive at the five-sixteenths pole, loomed a threat for the final furlong but gained only slightly. RICH FIND stalked the winner four wide into the final furlong and flattened out. EVIL EYE ALY settled in behind horses early, was never far back, angled six wide for the drive and failed to respond. SING SOFTLY, unhurried near the inside, swung out six wide at the quarter-mile ground but failed to respond. MISS GOOSEBUMPS was outrun and eight wide in the stretch run. SLAMMIN' LIL chased the winner four wide to the stretch and tired.
