SON OF A CHIEF behind the leaders, challenged three wide leaving the turn and drew off under steady urging. SHERLOCK within striking distance, moved to a forward position four wide late on the turn but lodged only a mild bid and prevailed for the place. PRIZE MASTER close up along the inside, angled out once in the stretch but lacked a late bid. LOVIN THE MOMENT forwardly placed off the inside, tired. MOTOWN BLUES four wide into the turn when within striking distance, lacked a rally. WILDERNESS FORCE vied for the lead near the rail and tired in the drive. MOHICAN forced the pace off the inside and also tired. BE A PRINCE in the three path on the turn, could not menace. NITETIME SPLENDOR was outrun. MY ROCKET MAN five wide with three furlongs to go, could not threaten. PITAYA was no factor.
