STAKES Early Times Mint Julep H. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Saturday, May 29, 2010. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner given by Early Times. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, May 22, 2010 with 33 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Sixteenth mile.)

HOT CHA CHA close up while off the rail, saved ground on the second turn, made a run at the leader from the rail inside the final furlong and edged off late. ACOMA in hand for a half while off the rail, made a good middle move, angled out for the drive and rallied willingly. KEERTANA forwardly placed three wide, challenged before a half, took over in midstretch and held on gamely. MY BABY BABY close up early along the inside, challenged before a half, battled to the final furlong and tired. WINTER'S CIRCLE set the pace off the inside, held on well to the quarter mile marker and tired. ABSOLUTELY CINDY was outrun.
