MEISTERSINGER within striking distance three wide, responded in the stretch and closed well late to be up in time. SCOTUS set the pace off the inside, responded when headed on the second turn, steadied in midstretch when ALSTOM drifted in then came again late. ALSTOM forced the pace off the inside, gained a short lead before a half, managed a slim advantage into the stretch, drifted in with a furlong to go when moving clear then faltered late. PLEASANT RUN close up while off the inside, dropped back on the backstretch then improved his position late. SUPREME RULER reserved four wide, lacked a closing bid. GENTLE TAP close up along the inside, faded in the drive.
