Footnotes

ROENA angled in early to press front-running PUNCHIN' GAL three or four wide, took over entering the lane and widened late under urging. TIME TO LIVE, well placed inside from early on, saved ground until the final quarter, angled five wide for the drive but wasn't a threat to ROENA late as second best. PUNCHIN' GAL gained the lead early, maneuvered near the inside, made the pace until the final quarter and weakened gradually. CONSOLING GRANNY, never far back while near the inside between foes, angled five wide for the drive but lacked a late response. SQUAW SPIRIT, five or six wide throughout, couldn't produce a closing bid. LOSTRIVERSPROSPECT, outrun near the inside to the stretch, improved position while continuing inside but wasn't a

threat. CARINA edged in early to track the leaders four or five wide, remained prominent into the lane and flattened out. ANGIE'S CAT wasn't a factor. SERMON tired on the turn. GILDED BELLE was outrun. DO I MAKE YA RANDI bobbed sharply at the start, raced six wide and tired upon going a half. TRAVLIN CAT faded on the turn.
