MAY GATOR settled in behind rivals early, eased out five wide on the backstretch, continued five wide while advancing into the lane, caught front-running SILENT STREAM a furlong out and drove clear late while drifting out. SILENT STREAM broke a bit to the inside, bumped the side of the gate and lightly with REASON TO TALK, contested the pace outside of SMALL PROMISES, gained the advantage nearing the first turn, edged clear, showed the way three or four wide into the final furlong but couldn't handle MAY GATOR late. GOLDEN MARLIN stalked the pace four wide, offered an earnest bid nearing the final quarter but was empty late. REASON TO TALK, bumped lightly at the break by SILENT STREAM, was never far back, edged up between foes on the far turn, moved with MAY GATOR while inside that one approaching the stretch, made a serious bid into the final furlong but failed to continue. ADALGISA, angled inside early, raced four wide while moving up on the far turn, reached easy striking distance a furlong out but lacked a late response. KISSINLEAF raced five wide most of the way and failed to rally. DICK'S CHICK exchanged bumps at the start with TO THE QUEEN, was outrun to the lane and passed tired foes. SWEET DEIMOS (GB) raced near the inside in a striking position to the stretch and tired. TO THE QUEEN exchanged bumps at the start with DICK'S CHICK and was outrun. SMALL PROMISES vied for the lead inside early and faded on the far turn.
