Footnotes

DYNAMITE LUV went up early to vie for the lead three abreast in hand, took over on the backstretch and opened a clear lead, made the balance of the pace and was under strong handling to hold TIAZO safe. The latter, never far back while three or four wide, moved between foes into the stretch, loomed prominently outside the winner for the last eighth but wasn't quite good enough. DIAMOND BRACELET, unhurried early, saved ground, came out five or six wide to rally leaving the second turn reached easy striking distance a furlong out but lacked a final response. SATIN PILLOWS, steadied sharply between foes nearing the first turn, recovered to race prominently outside of DYNAMITE LUV, was just off the winner for the drive but flattened out. OCEAN ISLE, outrun for nearly six furlongs while three or four wide, came out farther on the course for the drive and improved position while unable to menace. CALUMET SPICE (IRE) broke out at the start and slammed with MISS MATTIE MU MU, recovered to tracked the leaders four or five wide but was empty in the drive. JEALOUS WILDCAT gained a slim lead inside early while dueling with the winner, lost the lead to that one entering the backstretch and weakened thereafter. DEARFRIENDOFOURS drifted out at the start, raced five or six wide much of the way and wasn't a factor. RHODELIA tired after a half. MISS MATTIE MU MU broke in at the start and slammed with CALUMET SPICE (IRE), then failed to menace.
