Footnotes

REDI ROLLER maneuvered in behind foes early, was steadied at the three furlong marker when lacking room, came out between foes leaving the second turn, raced six wide and was hard ridden to prevail. SUPPLE worked her way near the inside early, made a bold run from the rail but wasn't good enough. SHIELD drifted out a bit at the start, was never far back, raced four or five wide, gained a slight edge a furlong out but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. MAYA MECCA gained the lead inside early, made the pace into the upper stretch and weakened. COOL BEAUTY bumped the gate at the break, was rated along in behind the leaders while between foes, weakened leaving the second turn. MRS. STEPHENS hopped while breaking slowly, was outrun to the far turn, moved out wide to advance but lacked a serious response. BERNSTEIN'SGODDESS bore in at the start bumping SILQUEST, pressed front-running MAYA MECCA to the stretch and tired. SISIA, steadied near the first turn and fanned five wide, continued five wide the remainder and tired. SILQUEST, bumped at the start by BERNSTEIN'SGODDES and steadied, raced near the inside and never menaced.
