Footnotes

FLEUR DE LILLY close up three wide, challenged once in the stretch, took over with a furlong to go and lasted late. FRANCES GARDNER reserved off the rail, angled out to the three path on the second turn when rallying, reached a forward position with a furlong to go and was gaining late. LOADED LADY within striking distance three wide, lacked a late bid. NOYOUCAN'T alternated for the lead along the inside while in hand, stayed on well to the final furlong and weakened. VEE angled in early, saved ground on the second turn, moved through close quarters near the sixteenth marker but lacked a late bid. OVERTIME BELLE reserved off the rail, angled out for the drive but had little left late. MEANERTHANU vied for the lead off the rail, held on well to the final furlong and weakened. DOGTOOTH VIOLET close up while off the rail, tired.
