Footnotes

CRUISE DIRECTOR tracked the pace four wide, took over after a half, opened clear entering the stretch and held sway. ZERO X ZERO settled in hand, moved up three wide through the turn, angled out four wide entering the stretch and was making up ground. FEATURE WINNER vied three wide, weakened between horses during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. KENTUCKY LIGHTNIN was allowed to settle, angled out five wide and improved position. ROCKEFELLER (BRZ) was forwardly placed along the inside through the turn and tired. FLEET DECISION set the pressured pace between horses, was headed after a half and gave way. GOLF PRO broke slow and was never a factor. MUCHO MOJO broke awkwardly and bobbed, and showed little thereafter.
