A GIRL NEEDS CASH went up early to contest the pace outside of MISS KITTY'S CITY, gained command on the turn, widened a bit into the stretch and was kept to her task. COUNTRY MARQUET, well placed while following the winner four or five wide from early on, wasn't a threat in the drive as second best. CIRQUE VIEW, bumped at the break and outrun for a half, made a mild bid to reach contention in the upper stretch but failed to seriously gain thereafter. EYES OPEN failed to rally in an even effort. STEALTH, within striking distance for a half, made a bid when straightened for the drive but flattened out soon after. MISS KITTY'S CITY drifted out at the start bumping ITSAPRINCESS, went up to vie for the lead from the inside and faded leaving the turn. PETITE'S DOWERY raced in a striking position five wide for a half and tired. GOLDEN SLIVER came out at the start bumping CIRQUE VIEW and was outrun. ITSAPRINCESS, bumped at the start, was never prominent.
