Footnotes

APASIONATA SONATA, within easy striking distance while following the leaders five or six wide, advanced steadily from that position into the stretch and won going way under strong handling. LADY FROM SHANGHAI, close up inside early, eased outside of pacesetter COUNTFORJUDGEMENT on the backstretch, gained a slim lead in the upper stretch, then wasn't a match for the winner late. RUTLEDGE DANCER, in behind horses four or five wide early, came out on the far turn to follow the winner six wide, loomed a solid threat into the final furlong but failed to offer a further response. HIGHER CIRCLE hopped at the start, settled in a striking position in behind the leaders three or four wide, loomed prominently but flattened out. CRAZYBOUTAMERCURY, unhurried while in behind rivals four or five wide into the stretch, improved position but wasn't a serious threat. MUSIC MUSE, within striking distance near the inside into the stretch, flattened out in the drive. DANGEROUS GIRL, six or seven wide much of the way, failed to menace. ACADEMY MINISTER tracked the leaders in a striking position four or five wide into the stretch and faltered. COUNTFORJUDGEMENT gained a narrow lead early, edged inside, lost the edge to LADY FROM SHAGHAI approaching the stretch and tired. SHE IS A PISTOL, sluggish to start and eight wide for a half, tired thereafter.
