Footnotes

SET THE SAIL settled in hand, moved up five wide, came to level terms with a furlong to run and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. BELL BY THE RIDGE was allowed to settle, advanced between horses, came seven wide to make a bold bid but just missed. FILM MAKING broke slow, tucked in to save ground, took closer order through the second turn, came four wide, split horses and was making up ground. SETON HALL attended the pace three wide, bid between horses entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. TAHOE LAKE (BRZ) set the pressured pace off of the inside, disputed the issue to the final furlong and faltered. CHEYENNE NATION settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch, loomed a danger but weakened. POSITIVE SIDE settled between horses, moved up to make a mild bid leaving the second turn but failed to sustain the drive. RIGHTFULLY SO prompted the pace

three wide through the second turn and faded. AT THE PULPIT made a middle move five wide but came up empty after six furlongs and dropped out. DREAMS CUT SHORT showed little.
