BADOUIZM, within striking distance off the inside, made a three wide run on the second turn, challenged the leaders in upper stretch and drew clear under steady urging. ALWAYS SURE, forwardly placed while saving ground, was angled out a bit in upper stretch and finished willingly to be up for the place. EASTERN SHAMROCK stumbled at the start, was outrun early, made a good three wide run on the second turn but had no late bid. MISS LUCY sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside but weakened in the final furlong. ZIGGY ZIGNEW, unhurried early, was three wide into the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch but was no real threat. CARLITTA, within striking distance inside, hit the portable rail near the three furlong marker then was no threat thereafter. CORREOSO, forwardly placed while off the inside, stayed well to the stretch and tired. KIRSTEENA, unhurried early, raced off the inside on the second turn and had nothing left in the drive. STARRY STARRY NITE, closest to the pace off the inside, was through after six furlongs. RIBBONS was outrun inside.
