INDYGO SHINER moved to a slight lead inside early, went along under careful handling while dueling with KALU and MONSIEUR CAT, was headed briefly leaving the five-sixteenths pole by both of them, regained the advantage soon after, came out at the three-sixteenths pole and bumped KALU, disposed of those rivals leaving the furlong grounds, then gamely withstood STRATEGIC PARTNER in the late stages. STRATEGIC PARTNER, never far back while in behind foes four wide, came out six abreast leaving the second turn, was going well at the end but wasn't quite good enough. FAST CITY, forwardly placed while maneuvered in early, raced between foes three or four wide while advancing nearing the stretch, loomed menacingly when angled to the rail in the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed effort. KALU went up early to vie for the lead from between foes, reached the front leaving the five-sixteenths pole, was bumped by the winner in the upper stretch and weakened soon after. X COUNTRY, rated near the inside early, offered a mild inside gain. MONSIEUR CAT forced the pace four wide from early on, headed the winner between calls approaching the stretch, continued close up into the final furlong and faltered. AFTERNOON PLEASURE settled inside early, raced six wide on the second turn and failed to rally. BUNDY RUM angled in early, was outrun, came out nine wide for the drive but failed to rally. TARZAN CRY (IRE), forwardly placed inside early, faded nearing the stretch.
